Review the SWMP and start working on the various sections and come up with methods to address each section collectively. At this meeting we will begin working on the Chloride Impairment requirement (page 46-47). There are no Chloride TMDLs in the seacoast communities. The following seacoast communities have discharges to water quality limited waterbodies where chloride (Chloride) is the cause of the impairment as outlined in the 2017 MS4 permit (page 24-25): Dover, Durham, Exeter, Greenland, Portsmouth, Rye, Seabrook and Stratham.
