- What will the funds be used for?
 - A: This is to create a small pool of funds to be available to respond to opportunities to
 possibly contract out portions of work to help meet the NH MS4 requirements in a
 coordinated and timely manner.
- How will this benefit my community?
 - A: This collaborative would provide each community with allowances in sharing resources, taking advantage of possible grant funding, developing a source of funding for coordinated mapping, monitoring, system identification or other strategies needed to ensure communities can obtain and maintain compliance with MS4 requirements.

- Do we have to do this every year?
 - A: No. Additional funding contributions may be requested at a future date if the contributing municipalities agree that this has been successful and more opportunities arise. But that is not anticipated in the next year if at all.
- How many other communities will potentially participate?
 - A: About 19 out of 25 MS4s participate in the two regional coalitions. These will be the most likely to contribute if they have the resources.
- How much money might be in the pool?
 - A: We anticipate between \$20,000 and \$30,000.
- Who will hold the funds?
 - A: Nashua Regional Planning Commission will be the fiscal agent.
- How is this working with the Seacoast Stormwater Coalition?
 - A: They had 15 out of 20 MS4s contribute with approximately \$30,000 total. The ones
 that did not contribute so far do not regularly attend coalition meetings and may be
 very small municipalities.
