Who must file an Notice of Intent (NOI)?

- A municipality operating a small municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) under the 2003 MS4 permit
- A municipality newly designated as a small MS4 under the 2010 Census
- A "Non-traditional" publically owned and/or operated MS4. Examples include:
 - Hospitals
 - Prisons
 - Military Bases
 - Airports
 - Universities
 - Federal facilities
 - Highways or other thoroughfares

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Key NOI Facts

- The NOI notifies permitting authorities that you intend to seek authorization to discharge from an MS4 to surface waters
- The permit goes into effect on July 1, 2018
- File an NOI by October 2, 2018
